

Q and A for CWR Board Service

Who qualifies to be a Board Member?

Board Members may be any Individual Member in good standing who volunteers to serve on the Board.

Up to two Associate Members are appointed to the CWR Board of Directors.

What are the terms of CWR Board Service?

CWR Board Members serve an initial term of 2 years, with the option to renew their commitment annually for a total of 6 years.

What is asked of a Board Member?

- Attend Board Meetings (virtually and in person)
- Support CWR projects, programs and initiatives
- Serve as an ambassador for CWR
- Serve as a committee Chair/co-chair

What is the Board Meeting Schedule?

The CWR Board Meeting Schedule is set by the Board each year. The 2018 schedule is provided below.

2018 Schedule

2 in-person Board Retreats (Jan, May)
1 pre-conference Board meeting
Annual Business Meeting (at Conference)
8 monthly video conferences
4 to 9 committee meetings depending on the goals and objectives of the committee
